Corinne, Miguel, and their children were living in an apartment that was owned by a family friend. Despite being model tenants, the person they thought they could trust took advantage of them, and soon they had nowhere to go.

At TLC, Corinne and Miguel found a place where they could all stay together as a family. Today, living in their own apartment and both having good jobs, they have goals of homeownership and continuing education, and see bright futures for their children.

At any given time, there are approximately 100 participants living at TLC including 35-45 children


