

CAMP OUT

FOR HOMELESSNESS TO HOUSING

Guidelines and Expectations

1. You must sign up for the event and sign a waiver and media release.
2. This is a family friendly event. Children must be at least 9 years old and accompanied by an adult at least 21 years of age.
3. Youth groups must have one (1) adult for every five (5) youth. (Youth must be 9 years or older; adult chaperones must be at least 21 years old.)
4. Chaperones are responsible for their group at all times.
5. If you plan to attend alone, you must be at least 18 years old.
6. The Clipper Magazine Stadium will open at 5:30 PM on Friday, November 19 for the Camp Out event. The event will end at 8:00 AM on Saturday, November 20. Everyone must be off the field and out of the stadium by 9:00AM.
7. Everyone is responsible for their own sleeping gear (sleeping bags, tents, pillows, blankets etc.).
8. Everyone will be responsible for cleaning up their own area and for taking their trash with them.
9. NO tent stakes, Deet, propane or open flame, alcohol, drugs, guns, knives, weapons allowed.
10. People should bring flash lights.
11. Lights out will be 12:45AM.
12. The Clipper Magazine Stadium has bathroom facilities onsite with flush toilets and sinks.
13. During the evening, we will have games and prizes, hear testimonials from individuals who have experienced homelessness in Lancaster, hear about services Tenfold provides to help people that are experiencing homelessness, and watch a meaningful movie about homelessness.
14. Tenfold will also have a live feed to the ExtraGive website, ExtraGive Leader Board, and #ExtraGive Social Media.
15. This event is part of the Extraordinary Give. Every group or individual participant in the Camp Out event must sign up to be a Fundraising Champion with a profile page and set a goal for Tenfold fundraising efforts.
16. A limited number of computers will be available for Fundraising Champions. If you have a smart phone, bring it to promote your personal peer-to-peer page on social media throughout the evening.
17. Wednesday, November 10 at noon is the deadline for sign up.
18. Parking will be available in the Clipper Magazine Stadium parking lot.
19. Everyone is responsible for their own food/disposable utensils, plates, cups, etc. There will be no access to microwaves or refrigerators. If you or your group would like to bring take out, you can. There will be drinks, light snacks, and desserts provided.
