TLC is a 52-room shelter in Lancaster City.

It provides supportive services for individuals and families experiencing homelessness and is home to **Veterans' Victory House**.

- **Families stay together at TLC**
- Participants receive personalized case management
- Action plans are created for each individual/family
- Weekly health screenings are available for participants
- TLC provides support to find employment, job training, education, and housing

“The night I had my baby, we realized that we didn't have a place where we could all stay together. We got divided up for a while, staying with different family members.”

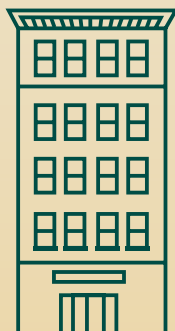
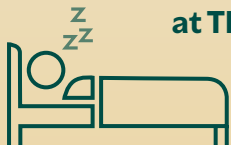
