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WORKSHOP **DESCRIPTION**

Identity Theft

Identity Theft Attendees learn the methods used to steal identity and find out how to prevent identity theft. The course will also address procedures to take if an individual is victimized. You will receive an email with the link to login and the workbook about 48 hrs.' prior to class.

Budgeting: Making a Money Plan That Works

This course gives tips and advice for designing a balanced budget and offers the opportunity to participate in budgeting exercises. Attendees are given the tools to create their own personalized budget, including recommended spending figures.

Banking Basics

Attendees are introduced to banking by learning how to set up and use a bank account, read statements, and balance a checking account.

Savings: Making Your Money Work for You

As an introduction to savings, this course teaches the importance of: setting up a savings goal, starting a savings plan and budget, and becoming knowledgeable about the different types of savings accounts and programs, including accounts with interest

Loans: When to Save, When to Borrow, When to Buy

This workshop is designed to be an introduction to the different types of loans (vehicle, education, mortgage, consumer, etc). Attendees will learn to search for reputable loans, as well as understand the steps needed to apply for loans.

How to Raise Money-Smart Kids

This workshop is designed for parents who want to help children develop the financial skills needed to survive and thrive as adults. Our intention is to give you something you can refer to in the future, and to provide the opportunity to think about what you'd like your child to learn about money. Raising money smart kids is about more than money. By teaching and reinforcing money skills, you raise children to be independent, balanced, able to use good judgment, and act responsibly within the family and in the community.

Imparting these skills does not require that a parent have any particular income level. Whether you are wealthy beyond belief or living on a fixed income and struggling to make ends meet, the money issues you'll encounter with your children will often be the same.

Many of us did not learn financial literacy skills and concepts at home and have grown up learning by our own mistakes. We don't want our children to suffer this same fate. This workshop will help you begin the process of raising money smart kids..

Homebuyer Education Class

This class will help attendees know if they are prepared to buy home. Homeownership Professionals will explore the lending process, mortgage readiness, real estate agreements, homeowners insurance, and the home inspection process. The class will provide a completion certificate that will qualify a buyer for special lending products and local downpayment assistance programs
